TEACHERS TRAINING CAMP

For the intellectual and mental development of the our faculties, regular training are conducted by the Banswara Pariyojana which are fully residential. This time, between 21 June and 23 June, the training of newly selected teachers was held at Banswara center, in which 216 Male and Female teachers of 153 schools participated and learned the teaching skills and on 26th and 24th July, 36 Secondary and Higher moderated by the project 14 teachers of secondary schools received training at places like village Chitri, Ghori Tezpur, Khamera etc.

In the month of August from 9 to 11 August the training was conducted at four places (Bhungra, Ghantali, Kalyanpura, Bhilkua) training of 405 teachers was completed.

In August itself, training classes were conducted by 290 teachers at four places (Bhungda, Dadodia, Anandpuri, Banswara) from 30 August to 1 September.
