#### **Schools and Hostels**

As per the nefarious plans of Christian missionaries to convert the tribals, Rajasthan also is the target like other parts of the country. The districts deprived of basic facilities is being converted by deception and temptation under the garb of service in this tribal dominated area of southern Rajasthan. The Naxalites are also spreading separatism in the region, with the goal of ending these anti-national intrigues in the area, the Banswara pariyojana has made schools and hostels a means to reach out to the brothers of these tribal communities who are neglected at the economic, educational and social levels. These initiatives are being run in southern Rajasthn districts of Banswara, Dungarpur, and Chittore . Schools and hostels started with the participation of the villagers with the basic mantra of education, rites and fraternity. Initially, schools were started in small villages through local youths who have studied 10th-12th, the students studying in these schools run by the Banswada project in a dedicated sense, with good values and good test results. Due to increase in the prestige and affinity of schools in the area, the number of schools in the area started increasing. At present 1275 teachers / teachers are providing cultural education to 25333 students studying in 334 schools (203 Primary, 93 Upper Primary 17 Secondary and 21 Higher Secondary) operated by Banswara Project. All the schools are accredited by the Department of Education, Government of Rajasthan.

- Students who have missed studies, and are denied admission in other schools, are given admission in these schools, so that they can complete their further studies and fix their future.
- All the other activities carried out in the area by the Banswara project, these schools have a major role in all of them.

## **Efficient adminstration of Schools**

Teacher's Training Classes: For the children to receive the optimum education, for the educational up gradation and all-round development of the teachers working in the Banswara pariyojana, two-day training classes are held twice a year according to the school's Calender, in which the educational lectures, Training of social harmony, Vandana practice, and physical education is given by the expert experts.

The following training classes are organized according to categories.

- For the first time in the project, training class of selected teachers is conducted independently.
- A collective training class of new and old teachers is organized.
- Training classes of teachers working in secondary and higher secondary schools are conducted separately according to subject and responsibility, in which they are given training related to subjects by qualified experts.
- A class of senior workers (selected) working in the project is also organized separately, in which the topics are discussed on time, diagnosis of problems in

## **Examination Department**

Over 25000 students studying in schools run by the Banswara project have two examinations (yearly and half-yearly), full preparation work including preparation of question papers, preparation of answer sheets for these exams,

examination department of the project is done one of these four papers, followed by the confidentiality of the question papers. Printing is done. Question papers, answer sheets and other materials are sent to the schools as per the code (CODE) prescribed for the school before the examination.

## **Sports and Cultural Competitions**

For the all round development of the students studying from Shishu Vatika to Class XII in the school run by Banswara Project, once in three years, in the year, three-day full residential sports and cultural competitions, according to the Barish Panchag (Caneder) of the different classes in the fixed place and on a fixed date According to more than 50 places are held simultaneously.

These three-day sports and cultural competitions include processions, songs, poems, bhajans, dramas in stage shows, solo and group dances and sports competitions like kho-kho, kabaddi wrestling, basketball, running, ball throwing, handkerchiefs and group adventure games. Occur.

- In this three-day sports and cultural competitions, the entire system including the living, eating and drinking of the students is done by the local villagers.
- On three days, the villagers of local and nearby villages participate in large number of programs and encourage the children, for three days there is a fairlike atmosphere in the village.
